In presenting these charts we feel that they will solve the problems of the many who have difficulty in finding the correct facing colours, lace, buttons and other details of various individual regiments. They are planned in a manner which presumes a certain amount of basic knowledge, but in that context, for an "at-a-glance" reference, unit by unit, they are proving of immense value to military historians, artists, model-makers, and in fact anybody interested in uniforms generally.

The charts are based upon reliable authorities, and are printed in a convenient 10" x 8" size which will fit readily into your existing filing system. Indeed, this feature has been thought out with care: thus, a square is allocated for your own serial numbering, and in many cases an additional space is provided for your personal notes. The colourings and details are listed in tabular form, by regiments, and finally, a list of authorities for further study affords a useful counter-check for the serious student.

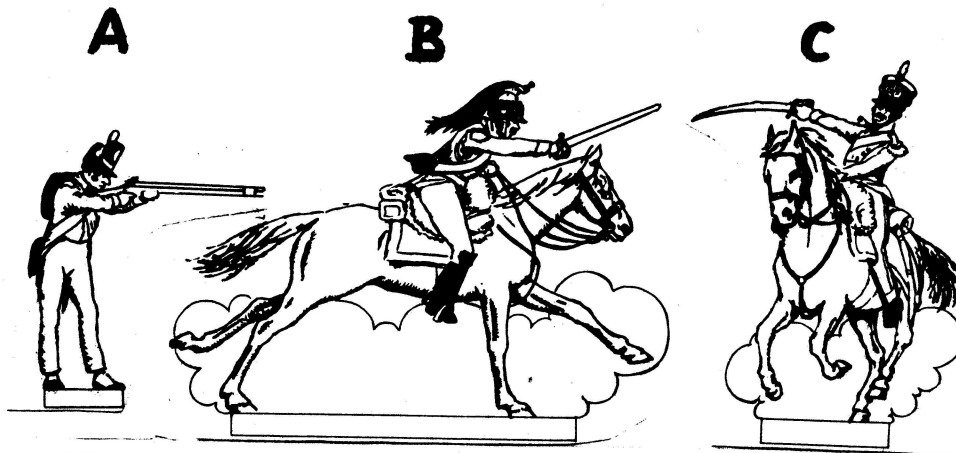

NORTH'S "PAINT-YOUR-OWN" UNIFORM CARDS

These cards are a direct response to the general demand for inexpensive yet well-documented information on the more popular periods in military history, and are particularly welcome in places where research may be difficult. They are based on sound authorities - contemporary wherever possible - and the authors have travelled extensively abroad in order to make on-the-spot research from first-hand sources.

You are probably already conversant with these cards, but if not, a specimen is attached to show their possibilities. They are issued in sets of six, in material suitable for water-colouring, which means that, in many cases, you are not restricted to the titles as printed, but can paint the figures in the colours of any regiment desired; and all issues after 19 carry a leaflet of concise historical notes which will enable you to speak - and even write - with authority on these subjects. A further improvement appears in all sets from No. 64 onwards, in which a more attractive pictorial effect has been achieved by printing the colouring instructions in the leaflet and thereby devoting the entire card to the figure alone.
